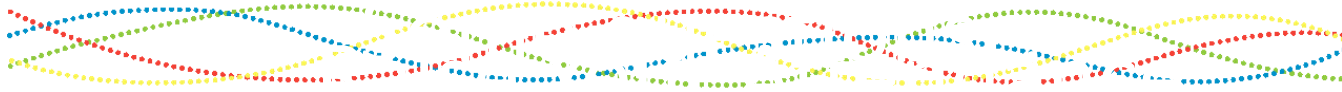

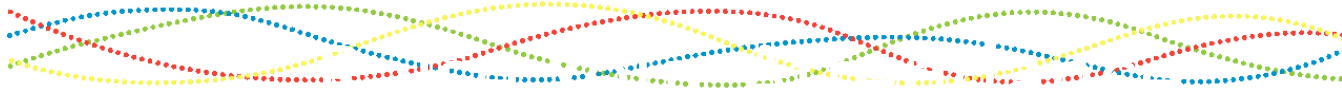

Do you think this is good?



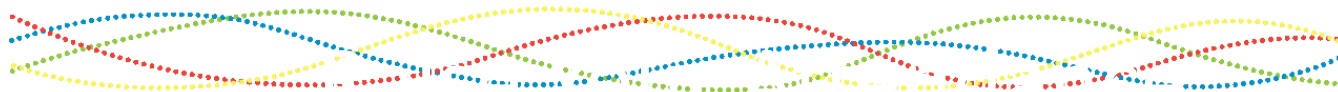
Raise Your Attendance

Or does it?



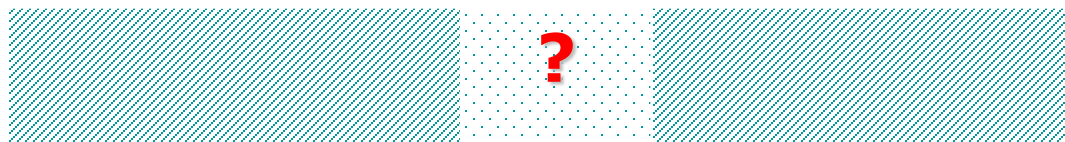


Raise Your Attendance

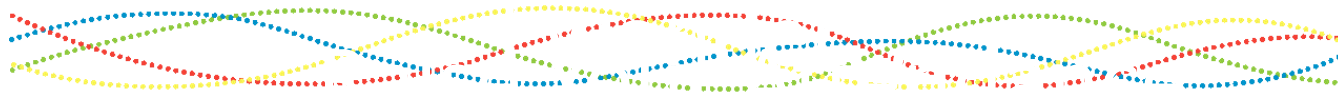
90% attendance = **½ day missed**

Mon **Tue** **Wed** **Thur** **Fri**



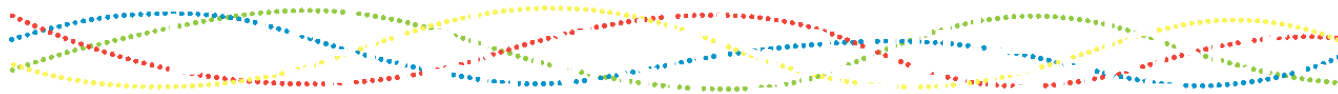
Absent half a day every week

That's practically part time!

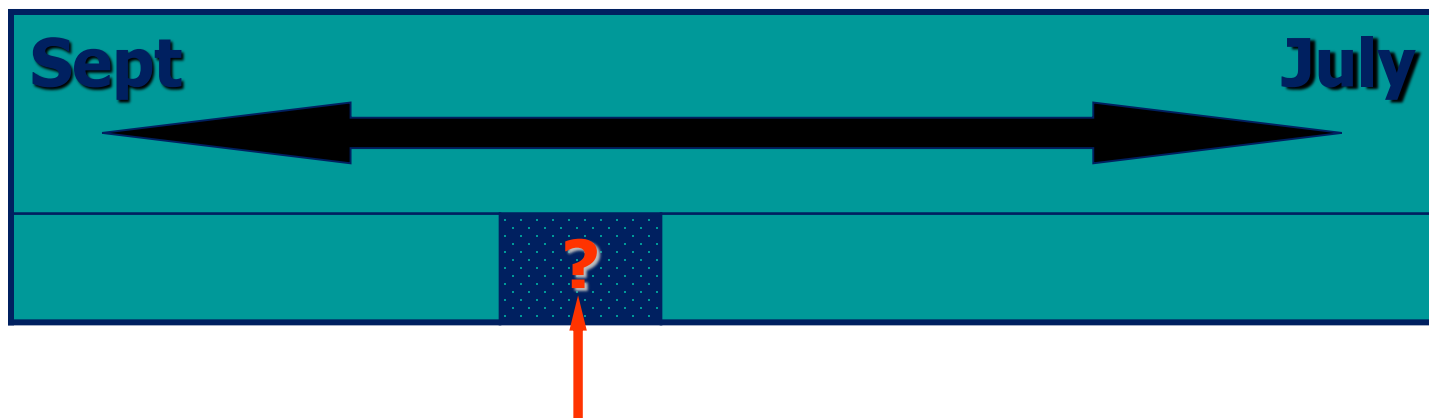


Raise Your Attendance

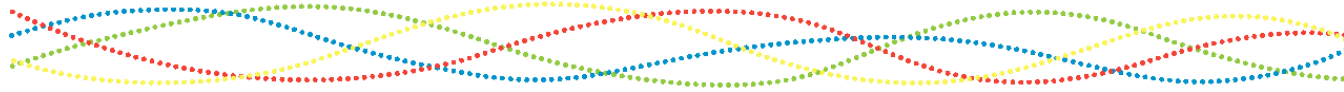
90% attendance over **1** school year =

4 whole weeks of lessons **MISSED!**

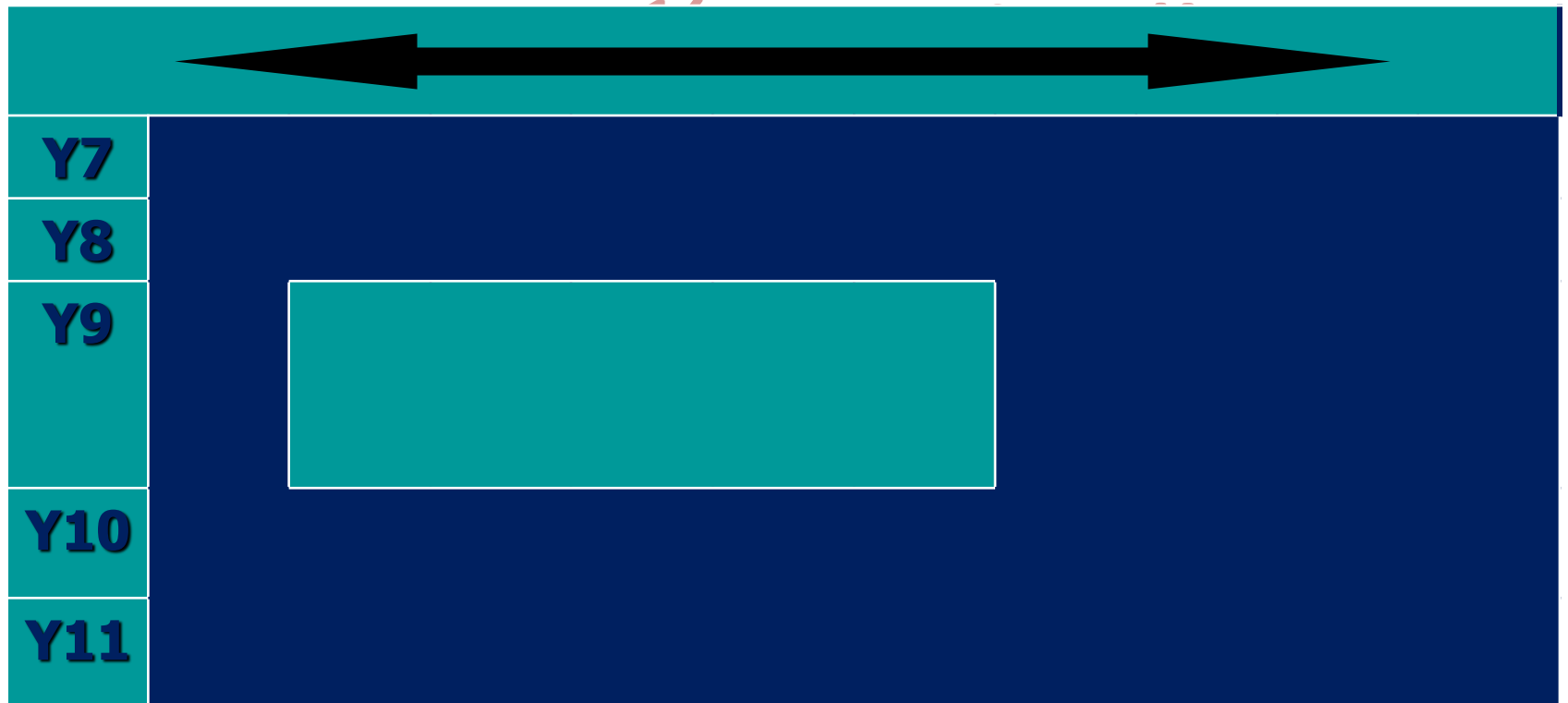
38 school weeks

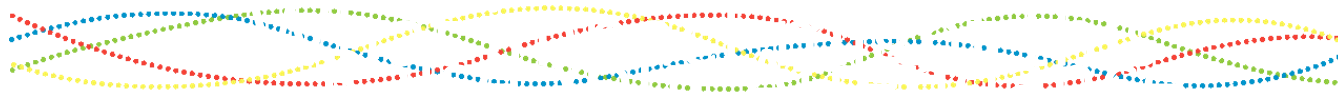


Absent for 4 weeks



**So, 90% attendance over
5 years of secondary school...**





Raise Your Attendance

Research suggests that **17 missed school days**
a year = a GCSE grade **DROP** in achievement.

Therefore, the greater your attendance the greater your
achievement.
