Attendance

We would like to congratulate all those students who have maintained or improved their attendance to 97% or above. Attendance has a direct impact on attainment. Typically, the higher the percentage of sessions missed across the key stage, the lower the likely level of attainment at the end of KS4. Students with 97%+ attendance last academic year achieved on average 2 grades higher than those with attendance of 85% or below. We want all students to achieve and fulfil their potential and therefore continue to have a relentless drive on ensuring students attend school as much as they possibly can.

Mobile Phones

Please can I remind students that mobile phones must remain out of sight on school premises. Students are to ensure phones are away before they enter the building and must not take them out until they have left the school premises.

Extra-Curricular Activities

Our activities for Term 1 are up and running! Please encourage your child to attend extra-curricular activities.
