RE: GCSE Geography Trip to Loggerheads – 3rd October 2023

As part of the GCSE course, geography students are required to carry out two fieldwork investigations, which will be assessed in Paper 3. To fulfil this requirement, we are taking the students to the River Alyn in Loggerheads Country Park on the 3rd October. The students will depart from school at 10.00am and will return to school at approximately 3pm.

During the visit the students will be collecting data from the river therefore it is essential that students wear appropriate clothing and footwear for the field trip as weather conditions can be unpredictable and footpaths can be uneven- we suggest activewear (**jeans are not suitable**). *Some* students may also be required to enter the shallow river for data collection. On the day students will need to bring:

- A bag
- Pencil case
- Packed lunch (Can request a FSM packed lunch on scopay if eligible)
- Wellingtons (or other water suitable footwear)
- Waterproof coat

We are asking for a voluntary contribution of **£6** for the trip to cover transport costs. **Payment and permission** can be done online via **SCOPAY**. Where you can leave emergency contact details and any medical details. If you are yet to register for Scopay please contact the School Finance office for all the details.
