**Achieve Together Evening: Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> September 2023**  
**3.00pm-4:30pm**

I hope that this letter finds you well. As part of our commitment to involving you fully in your child's education, we would like you to attend our Year 11 Achieve Together Evening on Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> September. With your child sitting their GCSE examinations later this academic year and GCSE mocks in December, we want to ensure that they have the best possible chance of fulfilling their potential in these examinations. In order to do this, I believe home and school must work together proactively to ensure that students are fully supported throughout their Year 11 challenges.

The aim of the event is for you and your child to meet with our Year 11 tutor team and our Senior Leadership Team to glean their expertise in preparing for the December and Spring mocks, alongside the summer GCSE exams. In order to offer our students the opportunity to explore a wealth of pathways that are open to them, we have chosen to bring together our Achieve Together Evening with our career fair.
