## **Year 11 Support and Revision**

Year 11s compulsory lesson six continues next term in order maximise the students' learning and preparation ahead of their March Mock series and summer GCSE series. ## **Mock Results**

During the afternoon of **Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> January**, our Year 11s will be participating in a GCSE Mock Result reveal. During this process students will open their results in the same format of the traditional GCSE result collection. Following the receipt of their mock results, students will have the opportunity to access career advice and guidance before having an assembly from Senior Leaders, providing advice on how to build upon their current successes and how to best prepare for the summer exam series.
