Please can I ask for your co-operation again in ensuring you don't park on Latham Avenue near the crossing patrol or in the local side roads. This affects local residents and also compromises the safety of our students – your children. A polite reminder that the taxi bays closest to the school should be reserved for school taxis that drop off our resource base children and only blue badge holders should use the disabled parking. I appreciate your support and co-operation in this matter.






SUBJECT IN THE SPOTLIGHT: **ENGLISH**


Each issue there will be a focus on excellent examples of work in both primary and secondary phase.





Squid Game is a new Netflix series which is based around classic children's games but IT IS FAR FROM SUITABLE FOR KIDS!





Create a Netflix Kids experience profile

One of the biggent advantages of Netflix is the ability to control what coolernt your children can watch. Setting up a Netflix Kids superience profile means that children only have access to TV shows and movies which have been carefully selected for kids. The lock and feel of the app is simpler and children can't access any account settings. kids

OR Switch off autoplay

Netflix has two autoplay features that can be switched on and off across different accounts and takes effect across all devices. Parents can disable the ability for consecutive episodes to play automatically and for previews to play when browsing. Both can belip to limit the amount of time children spend on the app.

Set maturity ratings & 18 block content

If your child in a little older, parsents can create a separate profile to their own and set a maturity rating that means children will see only TV shows and movie that fit that sating. 
