

Nursery - Practical Learning from Home



Here are a selection of different practical activities you might like to try at home - please just do whatever you can.

English	Maths	Wellbeing (PSHE, SMSC & PE)
*Continue to practise writing your own name. Can you write your surname? *Phase 1 Phonics Play "describe and find it" using toys such as animals, cars, trains, boats, buses and aeroplanes. Describe the toy but do not say the name i.e. it has 4 legs, a horn and a tail. Ask them to tell you which object it is and make the noise it makes. *Read animals stories such as Walking through the jungle, Dear Zoo, Rumble in the jungle or animal information books and get your child to describe the different animals i.e. the noises they make, patterns and colours on their fur, the way they move, what they eat and where they live. * Draw and label a picture of animal you would like see in a zoo.	*Use play dough (or similar) to make some 2d and 3d shapes. * Look at some 2d shapes and count how many sides and corners it has. Triangle, rectangle, square and circle. * Take it in turns to play guess the shape with your grown up by talking about how many sides and corners your shape has and see if they can guess what it is. * Go on a walk or in your garden and collect some twigs, pebbles, leaves or pine cones and see what shape you can make. Which shapes are easiest to make using sticks? Which objects are best for making a circle? * Cut out some paper shapes and create a picture such as a house, rocket, train or park.	* Run around your garden and count how many laps you can do? *Play walking through the jungle with your family and practise moving like a jungle animal, slither like a snake, stop like an elephant, pounce like a tiger, snap like a crocodile, run like a lion. *Lie on your back in the garden and relax all the muscles in your body. Carefully look at the clouds and see what shapes you can see. * Put on your favourite music and dance, can you create a dance routine for your family to follow? *Blow up a balloon and practice striking it with different body parts. What is the hardest item or body part to control the balloon with? What's your record for the most number of hits without moving your feet?
