

## **Nursery - Practical Learning from Home**



Here are a selection of different practical activities you might like to try at home - please just do whatever you can.

English	Maths	Wellbeing (PSHE, SMSC & PE)
*Continue to practise writing your own name. Using a baking tray sprinkle on some flour and let them practice their letters, use shaving foam, toothpaste, oil or paint.  *Phase 1 Phonics  *Put some toys in a bag that are easy to sound talk i.e. c-a-t, p-e-n, b-a-g, d-o-ll, d-o-g etc show your child the items and then get them to close their eyes. Next pick one out of the bag and hide it behind your back. Then sound talk the item you have chosen and see if the children can blend the sounds together to guess the item i.e. p-i-g pig.  *Use sound talk in your daily routine for example put on your c-oa-t, fasten your z-i-p, brush your t-ee-th, brush your h-air etc	*Make some number cards to 10 and practise finding items around the house to match the number card, 1 toothbrush, 2 pens, 3 spoons, 4 packets of crisps, 5 dolls etc  * Go on a nature walk and collect cones, twigs, leaves or conkers. How many of each did you find? Which was the most and which was the least?  *Practise making numbers from items in your garden such as leaves, stones or twigs.  *Practise counting to ten whilst you count, hop, skip or run back and to. Which one could you do the most?  *Hide number cards around the house and go on a number hunt. Practise putting them in order from 1 to 10.	* Have fun with water play by filling up balloons with water and draw on some eyes and faces. Practise throwing and catching the fish balloons who will get wet first?  *Practise moving like different ocean animals which animals are slow and which are fast?  *Go on a long walk and take your time to notice all the things around you, touch the trees, the ground, the flowers and look up at the blue sky. Don't forget to wash your hands. What can you smell? What can you hear? Did you hear the same things as your grown up?  *Practise learning to ride a bike. Don't forget your helmet!
