

Reception Practical Learning from Home



This week we are looking at Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs. Here are a selection of different practical activities you might like to try at home - please just do whatever you can.

English	Maths	Wellbeing (PSHE, SMSC & RE)
*Continue to work on letter formation groups learnt so far as well as the zigzag monster letters below. *Ask your child to help you write your weekly shopping list. *Talk about the story Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs (you can watch the link below on youtube). Discuss the feelings in the story – Was the queen kind to Snow White etc. Why might Happy have been happy – what could have happened? Why did sleepy never get enough sleep? What does bashful mean? *Snow White wants one more dwarf. Draw a picture of a new dwarf and give it a name. Can you write about your dwarf.	*The seven dwarfs need to get to work, pretend you are a dwarf and you have to get to work (you can pretend your bedroom is work). Make a map of how to get there counting how many steps you take each time. *Use some apples to do some addition and subtraction. Your grown up might say "Snow White had 5 apples but Grumpy ate 2, how many are left" etc. See if you can record some sums 5-2=3 *Make a tally chart to see which dwarf your family and friends like best – ask them why. (Miss Weston likes Happy best because she loves that he is always whistling and singing and Miss Stockton likes Grumpy best because she thinks he is cute!) *How many dwarfs are there? Can you spot the number 7 in your house – is it on a clock/tv remote/microwave? Can you send us some 7 photos – see if you can take the photo yourself! *Order number cards to 10/20 Can how many 7's can you see? What number does 7 come before/after?	*The Queen wasn't very kind to Snow White in the story. Try and make the people in your house smile by doing kind things and tell them why you love them. *See if you can see any shapes in the clouds – if it is a nice day, lie down on the grass and look up – what shapes can you see?

*Sleepy is always tired – I wonder what time he goes to bed? This weeks picture news is all about bedtime and bedtime routines. See picture news *Snow White loves apples – can you cut open an apple and see what is inside? Are the insides of other fruits the same? Can you find seeds in any other fruits?	*Make a Father's Day card for the special man in your life, it might be your Dad, Grandad, Brother, Uncle or Step-Dad. See if you can write inside why they are special to you.	*Miss Weston has been really busy in her garden and has to water the grass every night. Ask a grown up if you can water the grass or the plants for them. (Miss Stockton isn't very good at looking after plants and because they don't have water and sunlight in her office they don't live for very long and die). You could send us some photos of the plants and flowers you've looked after and send a video to us on Tapestry of you explaining to Miss Stockton how you look after plants and flowers – that would be so helpful!
