

Dinosaur maths book Have a go at the dinosaur activity book. You can use paper to help you answer the questions and draw the pictures yourself.

Dinosaur measuring

Can you draw or make a giant dinosaur?

Once you have done this see if you can find things that are smaller than it and things that are taller than it.

Remember some of the dinosaurs we learnt about are bigger than a double decker bus!!! Your pictures won't be that big!

Shape dinosaur

Can you use the sheet and build your own shape dinosaur? If you can't print it out, you can use the shapes for ideas and use your own paper.

Can you learn to tell the time? Have a look around your house for a clock or if you don't have one have a look on your grownups' phone or on the TV. In year one we need to know about o'Clock and half past.

How many different objects in your house tell the time? Do they all look the same?
