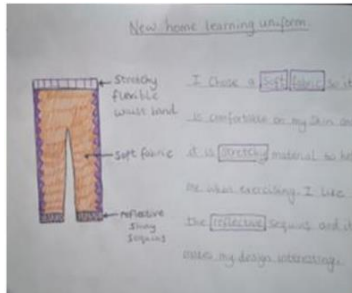

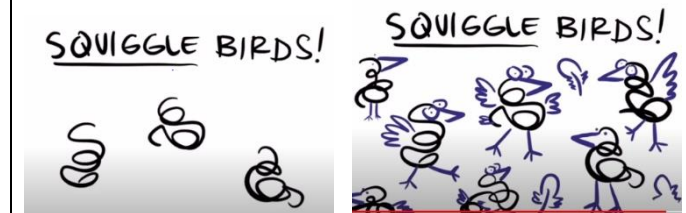
## Independent Learning
