Letter writing

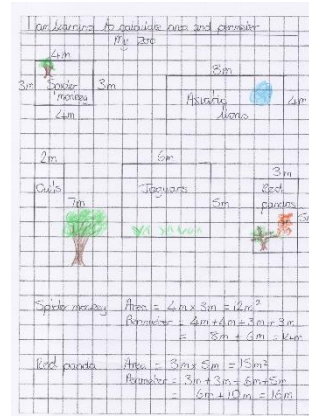

Create your own zoo. You need to draw a paddock or enclosure for each animal and calculate the area and perimeter for each one. You can count squares inside the paddock or multiply length x width to calculate the **area**. Remember to add up all the sides to calculate the **perimeter**.

Remember – a **polygon** is any 2D shape with straight sides; a **quadrilateral** is a 2D shape with 4 sides
