









Nursery - Practical Learning from Home



Here are a selection of different practical activities you might like to try at home - please just do whatever you can.

English	Maths	Wellbeing (PSHE, SMSC & PE)
<p>*Continue to practise writing your own name. *Phase 1 Phonics</p> <p>Use a bowl and play silly soup with a grown up finding objects in your house that start with the same sound, sock, spoon, slime, scissors,</p> <p>*Read the story of Jack and the beanstalk and then retell it to another family member on the phone.</p> <p>*Create a story map of what happened in the story by drawing pictures of the different events.</p> <p>*sing your favourite songs with your mum and dad.</p> 	 <p>*Count the teaspoons in your kitchen drawer. How many have you got? Can you order them according to size.</p> <p>*Create a tall and short beanstalk tower</p> <p>*Make some number cards from 1 to 10 and match different objects to your numbers i. 1 spoon, 2 cups, 3 pens</p> <p>*Count how many mini beasts you spot when you go for a walk.</p> <p>*Practise writing numbers with finger paint/ shaving foam or a paintbrush with water on your path.</p> <p>*Find out who has the biggest/longest feet in your house just like the giant.</p> <p>* Play how many claps game by counting together the number of claps (syllables) they can hear in words. Use words from Jack and the beanstalk and family members names. "Mis-is Day Mis-is Carr Miss Hil-ditch"</p>	<p>* Can you practise a new skill that involves being active? Try hopping on the spot, star jumps etc. How many can you do in a minute? How many catches with one hand can you complete? Can you stand on one leg and then the other leg for 10 seconds?</p> <p>*Build a cave made out of cushions and read your favourite book inside.</p> <p>*Lie on you back and place a teddy on your tummy. Take a deep breath in and watch the teddy rise on your tummy. Hold this for 5 seconds. Let the air out and watch the teddy fall. Repeat this until you feel calm and relaxed.</p> <p>*Play 'The Giant Says' (like Simon Says) jump up and down, stomp around, run, climb up the beanstalk, chop down the beanstalk, sleep.</p> 




Humanities & The World (Science, History, Geography & RE)	Creative (Art, DT, Music, Computing and MFL)	Independent Learning
<p>* In the story Jack sells his cow, can you find out what a baby cow is called? What other baby animals can you name?</p> <p>* Can you spot some different shape and colour leaves when you go for a walk?</p> 	<p>*Create a Beanstalk using leaves and sticks that you find in your garden or when you are out for a walk – is the beanstalk taller than you?</p> <p>*Create a musical instrument out of junk.</p> <p>*Help make a fruit salad – what will you put in it? Why? – How many portions of fruit and vegetable do you need a day? What do we need to do before we prepare food or eat?</p> 	<p>*Practise fastening and pulling up your own zips.</p> <p>*Practise putting on your own clothes in the morning.</p> <p>*Continue to practice going to the toilet by yourself, wipe, flush and wash your hands.</p> <p>*Brush your own hair.</p> <p>*Practise pouring your own drink at meal times.</p> <p>*Try a new healthy snack.</p>
