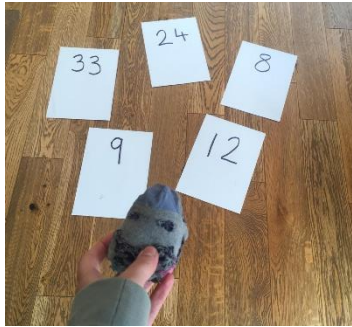


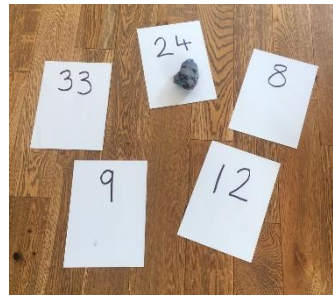
# Maths games

- **Target maths:**

Make some targets using chalk, buckets or some paper and write some numbers on them. Then, throw a ball, bean bag or rolled up sock to two of the targets. Can you add the numbers together?



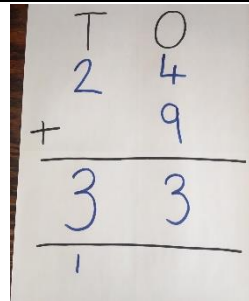
Make some targets. You can use chalk, buckets or paper. Then use a ball, bean bag or some rolled up socks like me if you don't have those!



Throw the ball/socks at one of the numbers. Remember this number



Then, throw your ball/socks at a second number. You will be adding these two numbers together.



Using your column method, add the two numbers together. Remember to keep your digits in the correct columns. How many different sums can you make?

- Make your own snap game (like we looked at last time) but for times tables instead of time.

- **Times table ROCK stars**



Paint or chalk your times tables on a stone. On one side, write the times table and on the back, paint the answer. Have a look at Miss Gittins' example.
