Remember to sound words out by yourself and use Capital letters and full stops. <i>My superhero has a long red Cape and Can fly high in the blue sky.</i></p> <p>Superhero story Can you make some superhero puppets and use them to tell a superhero story? You could use paper and lolly sticks or pretend your toys are superheroes if you want to. Who is the villain and who is the hero? What problem does your hero fix? You could video your story and send it to us on show my homework or email!</p> <p>Super Spellings Last Chance to check you know all of the year one spellings. Can you read them first and try and spell them without looking? Remember to practise them in different ways to help you remember.</p> <p>Reading Can you become a super reader? Superheroes love to read as it helps them to learn new things. How many books can you read in the next 2 weeks? You can use books from your house or oxford reading. The Challenge is on!!! Let us know how many you manage.</p> <p>Phonics Can you play a game with your adult or sibling? One of you be the superhero and the other the villain. Can you make some real and fake words on some paper? Then you can have a battle. The superhero has to find and catch all of the real words and the villain has to catch the fake words. Whoever does it first wins the battle.</p>	<p>Superhero subtraction Use the worksheets to be a superhero at taking away. If they are too easy can you make your own superhero number sentences up to 20?</p> <p>Superhero more than and less than Remember crocodiles love to eat BIG numbers! Have a go at the more than and less than worksheet.</p> <p>Counting Game Do you remember the counting game you used to play in Reception? 1N should definitely remember this one. You count backwards from 10 and you can do it in 1s, 2s or 3s. The person to get to 0 first loses. So, it could go like this Mrs Nelson: 10,9,8 Miss Hogan: 7,6 Mrs Nelson: 5,4,3 Miss Hogan: 2,1 Mrs Nelson: 0 ☺ You could even try from 20 once you get the hang of it or you could count forwards and 10 could be the number you go out on.</p> <p>Halves and Quarters Can you make your own sandwich and cut it first into halves and then quarters? When you are eating your sandwich use the language "I have eaten $\frac{3}{4}$ of my sandwich". You could even challenge yourself more and do it for your grown-ups also and impress them with your knowledge of halves and quarters.</p> <p>Move like a superhero Can you move like a superhero? Think of all the directions they go in. Forwards, backwards, left and right. They can do a half turn or a full turn or a $\frac{3}{4}$ turn. Can you follow some instructions and move like a superhero?</p>	<p>Be a superhero for a day Can you become a real-life superhero for a day? How many people can you help? You could help your grown up around the house. You could make a card for a friend. You could make a Cake for someone in your family. What thoughtful things can you think of to make people smile?</p> <p>Superhero Crafts We have attached some superhero Crafts for you to have a go at with your family. You can make your own superhero cuffs or superhero jet pack out of things from around your house.</p>  <p>Dance Party Have a dance party. Get your best party clothes and request some songs for you and your family to dance to and show off your favourite dance moves.</p>
