Expressive Arts and Design

Join different materials and explore different textures.

Begin to develop complex 'small worlds' with blocks and construction kits.



Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Physical Development

- Use a comfortable grip with good control when holding pens and pencils.
- Letter formation linked to phonics
- Developing independent skills such as putting own coat on, doing a zip and getting themselves dressed in the morning and at bedtime.

- Use the toilet independently



Communication and Language

- Enjoy listening to longer stories and remember much of what happens.
- Use longer sentences of four to six words and use words and actions in discussions.
 - Sing a large repertoire of songs.
