Dear Parent/Carer

As you may be aware June is PRIDE month in the UK. Activities will be taking place in both phases to raise student awareness and to promote acceptable.

### **Secondary Students**

During the week commencing 28<sup>th</sup> June 2021, students will be participating in a range of activities, including form time sessions and quizzes regarding PRIDE in order to aid their understanding.

The House Team will be holding a discussion session on **Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> June 2021** from the end of school until **3:30pm** for students who would like to be involved, to answer any questions they may have and listen to suggestions about how we can further support this community of students within school. The discussion session will centre around "What does it mean to be an ally?" and will include a mini workshop on being an ally. This will also give students the opportunity to meet other LBGQTQ+ students.

### **Primary Students**

During SMSC lessons, age group appropriate sessions, provided by Stonewall, will be delivered to students helping them to understand gender equality and rights.

### **Both Phases**

We will be holding a PRIDE day on **Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2021**. On this day, students are invited to wear a colourful PRIDE accessory such as socks, hairbands, bobbles or ties. Apart from the accessory, full school uniform **must be worn** including school shoes. If your child would like to wear an accessory we ask that a small donation is made, the donation will then be given to a PRIDE charity as chosen by our students during the discussion session.
